Who are we?

The Master's Handyman Service is a non-profit organization providing free labor for home repair and maintenance primarily for widows and the elderly. Our staff of personnel is dedicated to helping others and is also qualified to perform a variety of tasks. We are made up of volunteer and paid workers.

Why do we exist?

We believe the Bible teaches us to care for the widows, the fatherless, the elderly and others in need. For some, a simple task such as changing a light bulb, fixing a leaking faucet or drain, adjusting a door, caulking windows, or mowing the lawn, can seem like an impossible job. Sometimes it is not the lack of finances but simply the lack of ability, health or understanding, that keeps these jobs from being accomplished.

It is for these reasons that several men saw a need for an organization such as the Master's Handyman Service. Each of these men were unaware

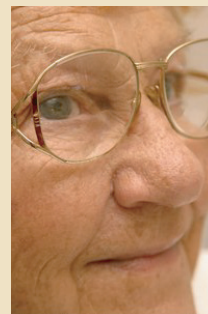
